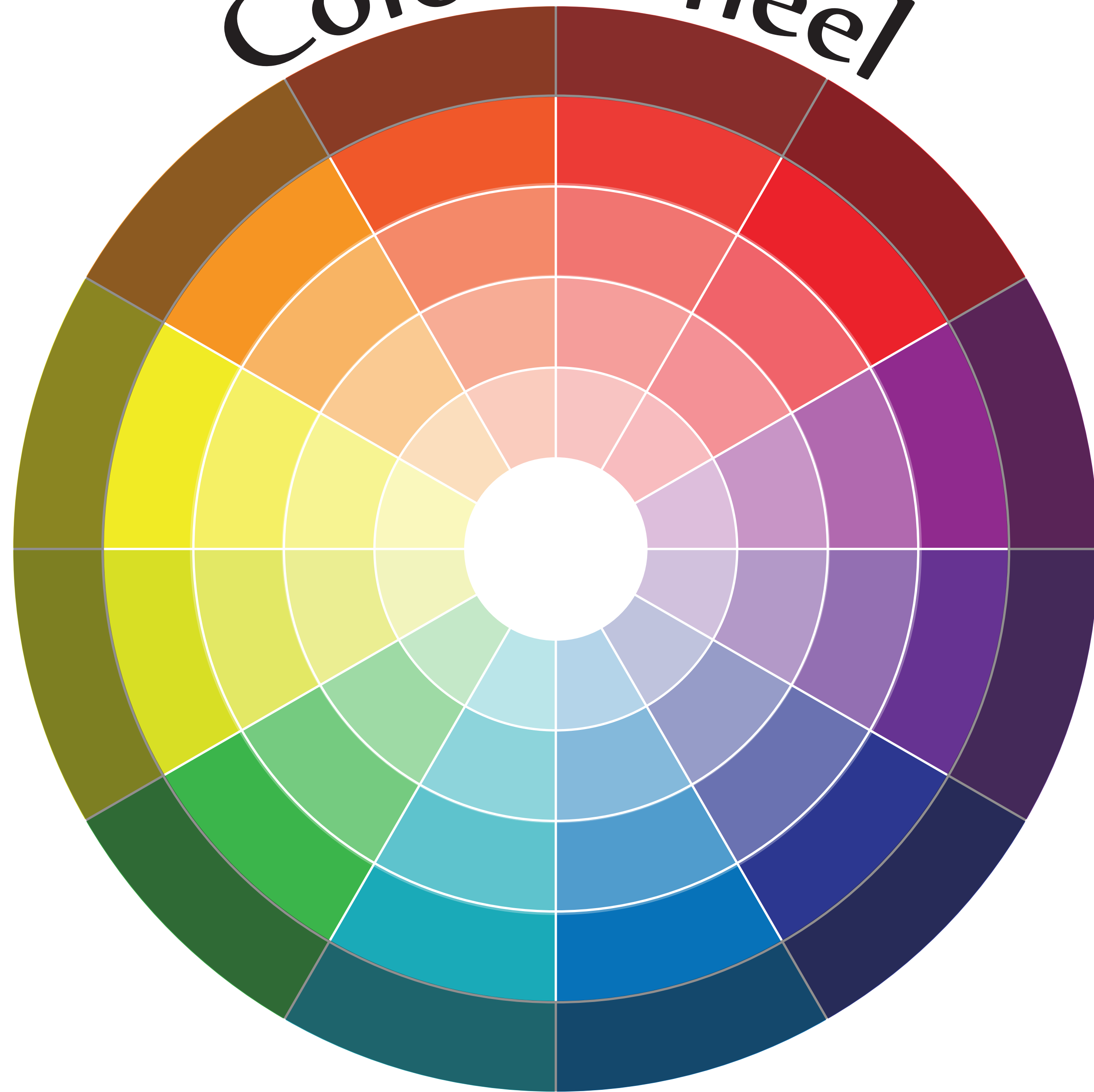




# Color Schemes

## Color Wheel



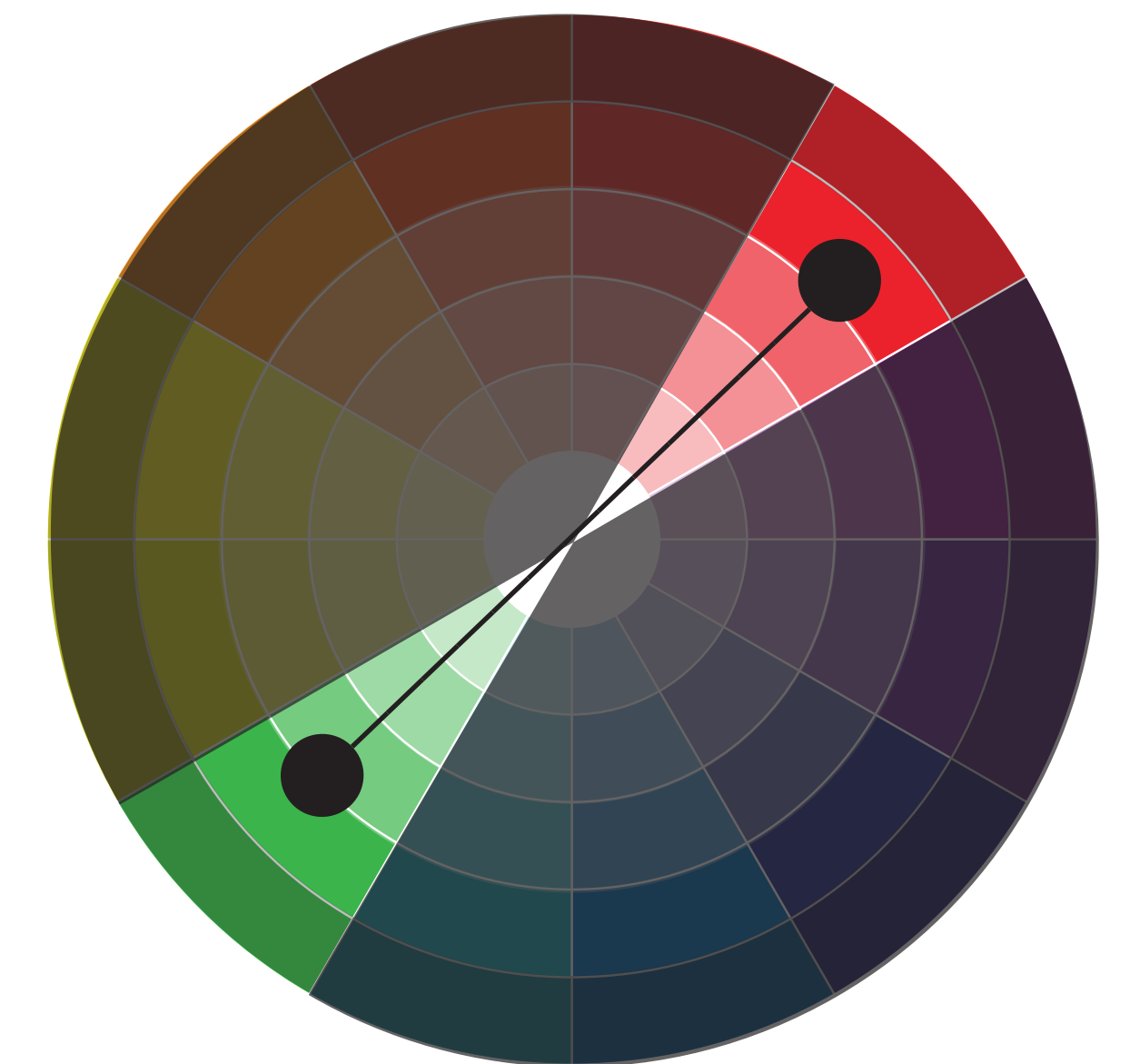
**Monochromatic colors** are all the hues (tints and shades) of a single color. As a result, the energy is more subtle and peaceful due to a lack of color contrast.



**Analogous Colors** are a palette of compatible color combinations that blend well together. They are neighbors on the color wheel.



**Complementary colors** are colors that are opposite each other on the color wheel. They contrast, enhance and intensify each other. Therefore, complementary colors need to be used with caution.



**Triadic colors** are high-energy colors that are found by choosing three colors that are separated by 120 degrees on the color wheel.
